Tiffany was a graduate of East Bridgewater High School, Class of 2000, Clark University with High Honors in 2004, and George Washington Law School in Washington, DC with Honors in 2007.

Tiffany was admitted to the Bar of Massachusetts and Rhode Island in 2008 and the Somensen Institute for Political Leadership of the University of VA, Political Leaders Program, Class of 2011.

Her career included a 1 year Judicial Clerkship at the District of Columbia of the Court of Appeals in Washington, DC. She also was on the Research Counsel, The National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers and most recently, The Deputy Chief Council for the US House of Representative Committee on the Judiciary Sub Committee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
