Hon. Paul Ferguson and Four Seasons Garden Club to Receive 2014 AGLA Equality Awards

November 25, 2014 - Each year the Arlington Gay & Lesbian Alliance (AGLA) presents two Equality Awards, one to an individual and one to an organization, in recognition of their record of working to improve LGBT equality in Arlington. This year the AGLA Board voted unanimously to honor Clerk of the Circuit Court of Arlington Paul Ferguson and the Four Seasons Garden Club with the 2014 AGLA Equality Awards.

Hon. Paul Ferguson will receive the 2014 AGLA Individual Equality Award. Several members of the Arlington Community reached out to AGLA with letters in support of Mr. Ferguson, including 2013 AGLA Equality Award recipient James Fisher. Fisher noted Mr. Ferguson's unwavering support of the annual Valentine's Day marriage equality demonstrations organized by the People of Faith for Equality in Virginia (POFEV), recounting how "Paul himself joined the group, thanking the crowd for raising awareness of the issue, expressing his support and apologizing for his inability to provide a license for same-sex couples to marry, under law." But Mr. Ferguson took his support one step further, he would welcome the couples up to his office and personally accept applications, "promising to hold those in wait for the couple until the law changed." In recognition of his leadership and compassion, as Clerk of the Court, and in his prior public service in Arlington as a longtime LGBT supporter, AGLA is proud to recognize Mr. Ferguson with the 2014 AGLA Individual Equality Award.

The 2014 AGLA Organization Equality Award will be given to Four Seasons Garden Club. This club describes itself as a "garden club mostly for the gay community, but all are welcome. Only requirement is love of plants." Our local chapter of the Four Seasons Garden Club helped to preserve elements of the healing garden formerly at Arlington's (now closed) Whitman-Walker Clinic, moving the beautiful and contemplative healing garden and labyrinth to Barton Park for all to enjoy. In support of the garden club's nomination, AGLA Past President Kris McLaughlin wrote: "Our gardeners deserve kudos for much and helping to make ours a thriving community." AGLA is proud to recognize the work of the Four Seasons Garden Club and its enduring work within our community.

The 2014 Equality Awards will be presented at AGLA's Annual Holiday Party on Tuesday, December 9, 2014, at Freddie's Beach Bar & Restaurant in Crystal City, Arlington, VA. A list of past AGLA
